

The Madeline Speer Knava Memorial Scholarship of The Greek Orthodox Church of St. Luke

Madeline Speer Knava (1924 – 2014) was a Steward at The Greek Orthodox Church of St. Luke. A life-long resident of Stafford Springs, Connecticut, she was educated in the town's school system and was Valedictorian of her class at Stafford High School.

Madeline furthered her education at the University of Connecticut where she received her Bachelor's degree Cum Laude, as well as her Master's degree, in French. She was elected to several scholastic societies, including Phi Beta Kappa.

Madeline taught French and Spanish at her alma mater, Stafford High School and was an active member in many of the town's civic associations.

Madeline was an active member of our parish and was enthusiastic and supportive of parish activities. Upon her death, she bequeathed a substantial gift to our Endowment Fund, which supports the Ministries of St. Luke that perpetuate the Greek heritage and teachings of the Greek Orthodox Church.

It is in her memory that this scholarship was created in 2017.

- All information requested must be provided.
- The following materials must accompany the application:
- An **OFFICIAL** transcript with a school seal in a separate sealed envelope
- **For HS students:** A letter of Acceptance from the institution of higher learning where student has enrolled or
- **For Undergraduate/Graduate students:** A letter from the institution of higher learning to show student has enrolled for the fall

- It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit requested material by **May 15**. The Parish Council will review the applications on this date.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

If applicable, the applicant, or applicant's parent or guardian, must be a member in good standing of the Greek Orthodox Church of St. Luke at the time of application, and for a minimum of three (3) years prior to the time of application. The applicant must be an Orthodox Christian and:

- must have been actively involved in the ministries of St. Luke for at least three (3) consecutive years. (Altar Duty, Choir, GOYA, Taste of Greece, etc.)
- must be a High School Senior scheduled to graduate in June; or a full-time College or Graduate student.
- must have an overall GPA of 3.2 as shown on the Official Transcript.
- must be furthering his/her education at an institution of higher learning during the upcoming academic year.
- must have been accepted for admission to an accredited college, university or vocational/technical training school.
- For the High School applicant, the course of study is for not less than two (2) years.

EVALUATION OF APPLICANTS

- Applications will be screened for eligibility by the Endowment Fund Scholarship Committee.
- Evaluation of the application will be based on the following criteria:
 - Academic Record
 - Church Participation
 - Essay Responses
